



Service during Blink Classics 60 km

It will be possible for team/support to help athletes during the race. BUT, - it is important that the instructions following below is followed to make sure the race can be arranged in a responsible, fair and safe way.

Organizer will have own mobile pole posts (on bikes) to help athletes in need of help. There are also 5 drinking station along the track.

- No private service-cars are allowed in the race. The organizer will have neutral service-cars providing help. Other cars will be taken out of the race.
- No cars or bikes are allowed closer than 50 meters from the last athlete in the peloton, and can only drive/ride closer when there is need, and when given permission. Organizer will have riders on bike on this distance and will decide at each point who that can perform service during the race.
- Exception from the rule above is the organizers own mobile pole posts (on bikes).
- When required technical help, the athlete needs to let themselves through the peloton to the back to receive help. It needs to be done on the right side of the road. We cannot tolerate cars and bikes blending into the peloton.
- It is recommended to show caution through the entire race, and that safety to the athletes is preserved in the best possible way.
- Organizer asks for these simple rules to be complied. Breaking of rules could lead to disqualification!
